Key Stage 1 Sports Day

Details:

- **Date:** Wednesday, 18th June 2025
- **Time:** 9:30 am
- **Classes Participating:** Classes 3, 4, 5, and 6
- **Location:** Shared field with Priory Junior School
- **Gates Open:** 9:15 am

Parents and carers are invited to come along and support our young athletes! You may enter through the main playground and walk down the slope to the sports field, or you can access the field via the gate at the bottom (Second Avenue).

The weather forecast looks like it will be very warm but we are starting at 9.30 before it gets too hot. Children will need to have -

- A full PE kit with appropriate footwear (children to come in school uniform as usual and get changed in school)
- A water bottle
- Sun lotion applied to protect against the sun's rays as well as a sun hat

The duration of the event is expected to be around 30 - 40 minutes. We encourage you to bring a chair for your comfort while spectating. We will also provide a limited number of benches and chairs for your convenience.

 - **Time:** Class 1 and Morning Nursery: 10:00 am (Nursery children have been given a time stating when they are participating if they attend for 30hours)
 - **Time:** Class 2 and Afternoon Nursery: 2:00 pm
- **Format:** Children will demonstrate their skills in balancing, running, and coordination as part of a team.
