Summer 1

Maths



In Maths, Year 2 children will be continuing the work they started in the Spring term on fractions, exploring finding fractions of shapes and amounts. We will also be learning to tell the time, practising telling the time for o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past the hour.

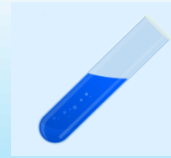
In Year 1 we will be continuing our work on measures, focusing on comparing capacity using the language full and empty. We will then begin our unit on multiplication and division looking at counting in jumps of 2, 5 and 10, adding equal groups to find the total and sharing amounts into equal groups.

English



We will be continuing with our work on the book Grandad's Island from the Spring Term and will be writing a non-fiction report about animals. We will also be exploring the text The King who Banned the Dark by Emily Haworth-Booth. We will spend lots of time immersing ourselves in the text to explore the language, imagery and technique that the author uses. At the end of the unit we will use our exploration of the text to help us write a persuasive letter.

Science



We will be investigating and observing a variety of different plants and learning about the conditions they need to survive. We will be growing our own plants and test our understanding of what plants need by performing a scientific test to see the effect of removing light, water and warmth from a growing seed.

PE



This term we will be learning a variety of net and wall games involving ball skills, special awareness and aiming at a target. We will play games such as badminton and tennis. We will also be taking part in a unit of dance, thinking about how to move our bodies with control and co-ordination and creating short sequences and motifs both with a partner and in a small group.

Computing



We will be linking our computing with our Art this half term and will be exploring digital painting programmes. We will be looking at the work of the artists Seurat, Piet Mondrian and William Morris and exploring how to use different tools to digitally create work in their style.

RE



We will be learning about Christianity and Judaism. We will be learning all about the Christian story of creation and how Christian and Jewish people believe the world was made. We will be exploring the importance of Shabbat to Jewish people and finding out how Shabbat is celebrated and why.

The Arts



In Art we will be looking at famous artists and looking at how we can recreate our own pieces imitating their unique styles. We will explore a variety of different artists including Jackson Pollock, Yayoi Kusama and Lowry.

In Music, we will be consolidating our understanding of the musical terms pitch, tempo and rhythm. We will be exploring different tuned and untuned instruments to reflect our understanding and compose our own musical patterns. We will also be exploring a range of genres of music and discussing how different types of music make us feel.
