Dear Parents/Carers,

Next half term our topic is 'Ready, Steady, Grow!' This topic has a Science focus and we will be learning about a variety of plants and the conditions they need to help them grow and flourish.

To begin this topic, we would like children to do some research into growing and bring their findings into school to share.

Your child's research can be presented in a variety of ways. Some examples include:

- Grow their own seed or plant (cress or beans are a good option as they grow quickly) and record a diary of the changes they observe as their plant grows.
- Create an observational drawing or a painting of a plant or flower.
- Draw a labelled diagram of a plant and its different parts.

The children's work will be shared with the class during the 1st week back and will be displayed in the classroom until the May half term.
