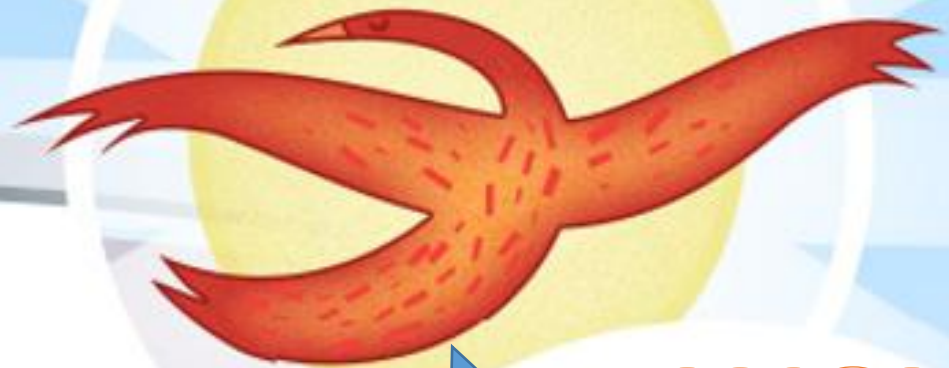

## Maths



In Year 2 we will be learning how to tell the time, focusing particularly on quarter past and quarter to and building to telling the time to the nearest five minutes. We will be learning the vocabulary related to describing position and practise giving directions. We will also be focusing on understanding and interpreting data and we will be answering questions about pictograms and block graphs. In Year 1 we will be learning to tell the time for o'clock and half past times. We will be learning about numbers to 100 and understanding the place value of each digit. We will be learning to describe position and direction using the vocabulary left, right, forwards, backwards, above and below. We will also be learning to recognise coins and their value in our unit on money.

## English



In English we will be finishing our work on the text 'Jack and the Baked Beanstalk' from the previous term, writing our own version of the story with a twist! We will then move on to exploring the text 'Rosie Revere Engineer' by Angela Beaty. We will spend lots of time immersing ourselves in the text to explore the language, imagery and techniques that the author uses. At the end of the unit we will use our exploration of the text to help us write our own stories and non fiction pieces.

## History



We will be learning about the Great Fire of London and why this was a significant event in the past. We will look closely at the different sources we can access today which help us to understand what happened in the past. We will learn about Samuel Pepys and the role he played in recording the fire. We will also learn about the impact the fire had on the future of London and how the buildings and street layouts were changed as a result.

## Science



We will be exploring different materials and thinking about if they are natural or manmade. We will look closely at the different properties of materials and think about why objects are made from particular materials. We will also be investigating how materials can be changed through squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

## DT



We will be exploring structures and different techniques that can be used to join materials together. We will look closely at the shape and foundations of structures to help us understand what makes a structure strong enough to stand up by itself. We will then use our understanding of this to design, make and evaluate our own building.

## The Arts



In Art, we will be exploring art from around the world using the countries involved in the World Cup as our focus. We will focus on pattern, silhouette and collage using different mediums of paper and mosaic. Through our explorations we will be developing our skills of painting, cutting, sketching and drawing.

## RE



We will be learning about key stories from the Christian and Jewish faith and thinking about the lessons that these stories can teach us, and why they are still important to Christian and Jewish people today. We will be learning about the importance of the Torah and the Bible and talking about the role God plays in stories from them.

## PE



This term we will be learning a variety of striking and fielding games involving hand eye co-ordination, throwing and catching. We will play games such as cricket and rounders. We will also be continuing with our unit on athletics in preparations for our sports day. We will be focusing on strength, fitness, speed and stamina.
